Prayer for the First Sunday of Advent

Jesus, bright morning Star, it's time for me to wake from the slumber of my ordinary life and find you in the holiness of this season. I pray today that the next four weeks will be a special time of returning for me—of rising each morning with a prayer and a desire to look for and find you in the details of my life. December is a month that requires so much of my time, treasure and talent. I will be pulled in many directions. Help me to focus on you, on that pinpoint of light that is sometimes hard to see unless I pause to seek and find it. Guide me to thy perfect light.



Welcome to the season of waiting. Okay, okay, okay, in actuality it's the season of Advent. But I like to call things what they are. And let's face the facts, this season is all about waiting. And it's not waiting-in-addition-to-something-else. Just waiting, sweet and simple. Might as well speak plainly, folks—name it and claim it, you know? We aren't a people accustomed to waiting. We

have instant messaging, after all. INSTANT. A century ago "instant messaging" was carried by a guy on a pony and took two weeks to get to Winnipeg from Toronto. If a package can't be delivered by Amazon withing two days, I cancel my order. I have to wait a whole minute for a video to load? What...do I look like I'm made of time? Waiting is uncomfortable for us. And Advent hits us right in the discomfort zone... with waiting. What uncomfortable things have you had to endure lately?

Communion Reflection...Calendars can be devious little creatures. They promise the illusion of structure and control, while lulling us into a false notion of "later." Who among us doesn't regularly scramble at the last minute, seemingly surprised that a birthday, graduation, Christmas, or other life event somehow snuck up on us? The calendar had assured us there was plenty of time. Yet while we were watching playing on our phones, later came now. For thousands of years, the Hebrews waited for a Messiah. Now, we often spend our lives waiting for a distant heaven in the hereafter. Love, however, is a now thing. The love of Christ is within us and around us always and everywhere. Ready to erupt upon our lives the moment we are open to it. All of God's creation calls us to share love now. "Stay awake!" Jesus exhorts. Advent calls us to live with eyes wide open, so we won't sleep through our own life while betting on a next week, next month, or next year. Live, love, and laugh with a sense of urgency.
