

Communion Reflection...A family is God's gift to us. And this gift is given to us so that we can grow into mature and loving human persons. One of the very basic things that a family should give to each of its members is a deep sense of belonging. "Belonging is important for our growth to independence; even further, it is important for our growth to inner freedom and maturity. It is only through belonging that we can break out of the shell of individualism and self-centeredness that both protects and isolates us."



Humanity's greatest accomplishments would not have been possible without the basic skills of ordinary people. The heroic explorers of the world could never have left their shores had it not been for the craftsmanship of carpenters, sail makers, ship builders and metal workers.
