Can I wait in confidence that the promises God had made will be fulfilled? If I rush through my days unreflectively, or worse, clinging tightly to my selfishness, what do I hope to gain in my life? Let us be people who wait on God's every word so we can be transformed and offer our new selves as gifts.


