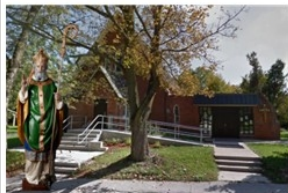

Law enforcement agencies as well as financial and medical institutions constantly remind us of measures we should be taking to guard our personal information. We are warned against allowing others to view passwords, PIN

numbers or other materials that might give unwanted access to those who could threaten our welfare. God knows all sorts of things about every one of us. At times we try to hide things from Him by quietly going about our lives without mentioning how troubled we are by what we've done or failed to do.

Despite our efforts at concealment, God continues to give us gifts we know we don't deserve. We ask ourselves, "Doesn't He know how bad I am?" "Did I really manage to hide it from Him?" The answer is "Yes" He knows everything. What we don't know is how much He loves us and how much happier we'd be if we just faced our past faults and moved on from there. You're not hiding anything from Him. You're hiding a lot of joy from yourself.

**Communion Reflection..** The most important thing about each of us is our capacity for goodness. We can be a source of light. We have hands that can care, eyes that can see, ears that can hear, tongues that can speak, feet that can walk, and above all hearts that can love. Unfortunately, through laziness, selfishness, and cowardice, our light can be dimmed, so that we become shadows of the people we could be. Lord, help us to believe in our own goodness, and to let the light of that goodness shine. On seeing this light others find their way, and you will be glorified.

Most of us are more than aware of how imperfect and weak we are. How do we feel when we hear Jesus address us as the salt of the earth and the light of the world? Is this just another example of how wide a difference there is between the Gospel ideal and how you and I really live our lives? Or is it

possible to be weak and, at the same time, be the light of the world? When we try to put these two different ideas together – being imperfect, yet being salt and light – we can't think the way the world thinks. If we do, then we will find ourselves at a dead end. If, in prayer, you pretended that you were perfect, your prayer wouldn't be genuine. When we come before the Lord, we come as we are – with all of our imperfections, our sinfulness and sadness, our doubts and desires. We come as pilgrims – as people still engaged in the struggle of life. To place ourselves before the Lord as perfect examples of Christianity would be nothing less than utter foolishness. Just as those first followers of Jesus had many weaknesses to deal with, so do we. And so it is in both our strength and our weakness that we are called to be salt and light.
