

**Stewardship Reflection
18th Sunday in Ordinary Time**

1st Reading: Exodus 16:2-4, 12-15

2nd Reading: Ephesians 4:17, 20-24

Gospel: John 6:24-35

Believe In The One He Sent

In today's gospel, a crowd of Jesus' followers ask this question: "What can we do to accomplish the works of God?" This question plagues many people who want to participate in God's plan but have no idea where to start.

Discipleship is filled with tasks that seem overwhelming and even impossible for man to accomplish. But Jesus makes it simple for us. His response to the question: "This is the work of God, that you believe in the one he sent."

There is no need for us to overcomplicate things. God equips us for the difficult tasks. Our job is to humble ourselves and place our faith in Christ alone, through whom all things can be done.

In Discipleship we respond, fiat, to his challenging yet loving invitation. St. John Paul II wrote "...Mary as Mother became the first 'disciple' of her Son, the first to whom he seemed to say: 'Follow me...'"

Questions to help you prayerfully hear what He is invited you to

Jesus challenges the crowds who came after him. Instead of being flattered by their desire to find him, he challenges them to consider more deeply what it is they are looking for. Is God challenging you in any areas of your life? In any of your relationships?

Jesus encourages the crowd to "work" not for things that are perishable--that don't last--but for the eternal. Right now, in your life, what is it you are working for?
