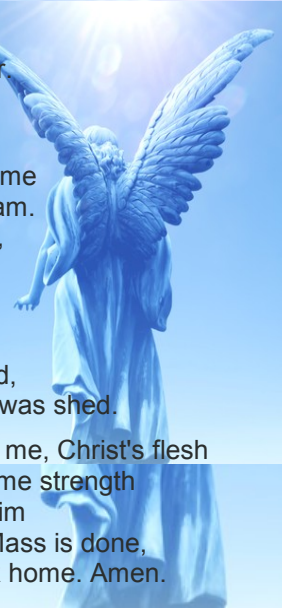
*Prayer to Guardian Angel

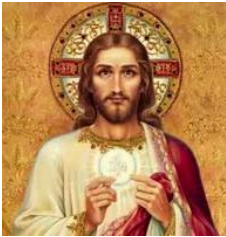

**Stewardship Reflection**  
**19th Sunday in Ordinary Time**

1st Reading: 1 Kings 19.4-8  
2nd Reading: Ephesians 4.30-5.2  
Gospel: John 6:41-51

*Open Your Mind*

The opening verse of today's gospel is troubling: "The Jews murmured about Jesus..." The word murmuring does not imply that the Jews were discussing the merits of Jesus' message. We murmur secrets, lies, and rumors, not compliments. Clearly, the Jews didn't like Jesus or what He had to say. The thing is, we don't get to judge God's messengers. When God chooses to relay a message, we must be alert and listen, even when we don't really care for the messenger. That person might be a meddling neighbor, a persnickety family member, an unpopular politician, or a cranky old pastor. It doesn't matter! Each one of those people can be used as an instrument of God, and missing the message because of your disdain for the person could prove to be spiritually fatal! Jesus told the Jews that He was the bread of life — the way to the Father! They resisted that message. They resisted the draw of the Father! Let us learn, then, to be humble, alert, and open-minded as we grow in our ability to disciple and evangelize others, allowing them to do the same for us!

- The crowd pressed Jesus for a sign (6:30). He told them that He Himself is the sign: the Bread of Life. Then they began to murmur; they cannot believe this teaching. Is or was the doctrine of the Real Presence of the Eucharist difficult for you to believe, either now or in the past?
- Jesus speaks symbolically in other passages of John's Gospel, such as being born from above (Ch. 3) and the parable of the Vine and the Branches (Ch. 15). However, this passage is different because Jesus is speaking literally. He truly means that The Bread of Life is His "flesh for the life of the world." The Eucharist is literally Jesus' Body; does this change how you might approach the Mass in the future?

Sometimes people around you might not believe in Jesus or what

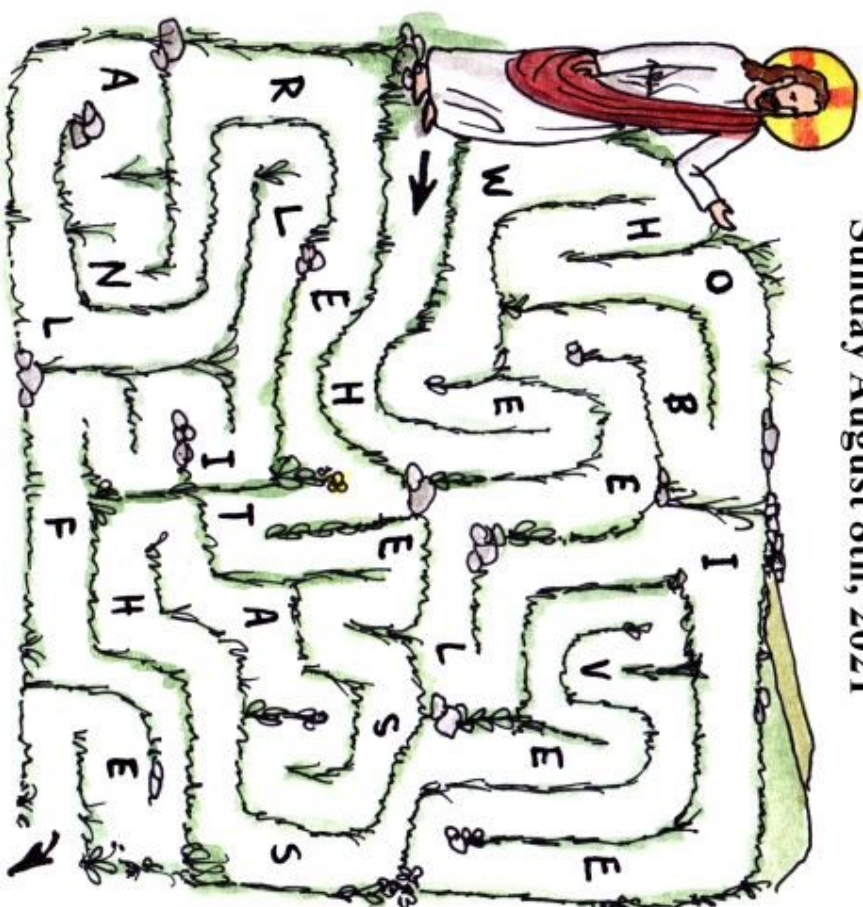
He says. If that happens, remember to trust Jesus. Even in His own

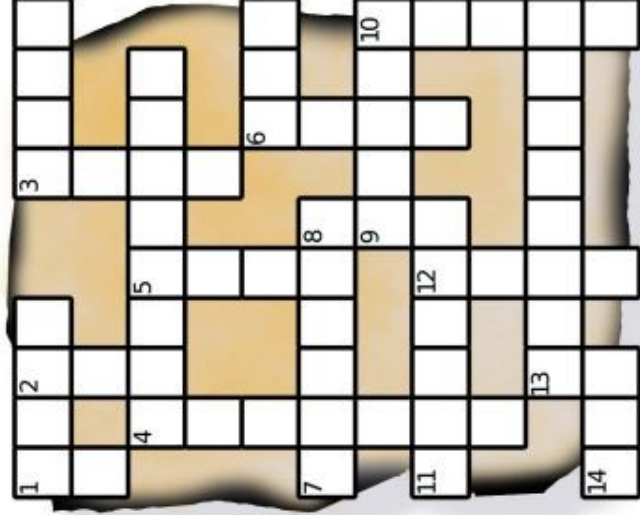
