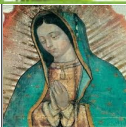

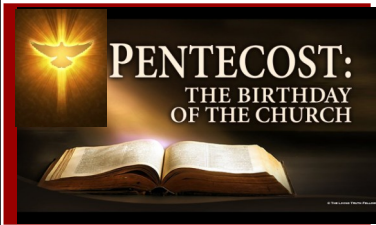

### Reflect
