### The Immaculate Heart of Mary

The Church dedicates the month of August to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. It is a dogma of the Catholic faith that Mary is the Immaculate Conception; that is, in preparation for the Incarnation of the Second Person of the Holy Trinity in her womb, she was conceived without the corruption of sin through the

foreseen and infinite merits of her Son, Jesus Christ. Over the centuries, as saints and theologians reflected on how Mary pondered and treasured the sacred events from the life of Christ in her holy heart, as attested in Scripture, her pure heart was recognized as something to be imitated. Devotion to Our Lady's purity of heart began to flower—so much so that in the 17th century, St. John Eudes promoted it alongside the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The devotion rose to a new level after the apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima, when Mary revealed an image of her Immaculate Heart to Lucia, Jacinta, and Francisco.

Stewardship Reflection

1st Reading: Daniel 7.9-10, 13-14 2nd Reading: 2 Peter 1.16-19 Gospel: Matthew 17.1-9

### Kingship of the Son of Man

The book of Daniel speaks about the Kingship of the Son of Man who is brought before the Ancient of Days and is adorned with splendour and glory and His dominion is declared for all ages. This prophetic vision takes shape in the Synoptic Gospels when Jesus is transfigured on the high mountain with a loud voice from the heavens proclaiming His Sonship. Stewardship transfigures us from within and makes us more like Jesus. The more we give to the Lord, the more he adorns us with His riches.

St. Thomas Aquinas said, "At His Transfiguration, Christ showed His disciples, the splendour of His beauty, to which He will shape and colour those who are His: 'He will reform our lowness configured to the body of His glory." This promise Jesus makes gives us great hope, especially in times of trial. Stewardship is one of the many ways in which God invites us to be a part of His Divine plan. But unlike the disciples in the Gospel today, we should never be afraid of hearing God's voice but rather be subject to His majesty.

In the Gospel, Jesus reveals to His disciples the full share of His Divinity. As St. Anastasius put it, "Jesus goes before us to show us the way, both up the mountain and into heaven ... Let us retire from the world, stand aloof from the earth, rise above the body, detach ourselves from creatures and turn to the Creator, to whom Peter in ecstasy exclaimed: 'Lord, it is good for us to be here." We must seek opportunities to grow in holiness and stewardship can help us to follow Jesus to the mountain whose light, in turn, radiates in us.

### **Clare and Francis**

WATCH

This outstanding movie is unique among films about St. Francis because of the historical accuracy of the story and its authentic spirit of joy and piety so characteristic of Francis, as well as the major role played by Clare. Both founded major religious orders, and together they inspired many to follow their radical call to live the Gospel.

### **Edith Stein: The Seventh Chamber**

This is a moving, artistic portrayal of the life of Jewish philosopher, Catholic convert, and Carmelite martyr, Edith Stein. It captures the interior struggles of this extraordinary woman, as well as the great conflicts from her decision to convert to Catholicism. Deeply influenced by the writings of St. Teresa of Avila, she joined the Carmelites, took the name of Teresa Benedicta of the Cross, was put to death in Auschwitz in 1942, and canonized by John Paul II in 1998. This film shows how two worlds, the Jew and the Christian, were united within her in absolute coherence in her search for truth. This movie is not rated, but was created with an adult audience in mind.

We would recommend Parental Guidance and that parents preview it before watching it.




