

Stewardship Reflection

ENTERING INTO THE ADVENT SEASON: First Sunday of Advent Reflection

1st Reading: Isaiah 63.16b-17; 64.1, 3-8 2nd Reading: 1 Corinthians 1.3-9 Gospel: Mark 13.33-37 **Preparing Ourselves for Christ**

This 1st Sunday of Advent marks the beginning of a new liturgical year. The readings during this time of preparation focus on making us aware that it's time to rouse from our sleep and prepare for the Lord's coming. Jesus says in the Gospel to "keep awake - for you do not know when the master of the house will come."

One great way to invite the light of Christ into our lives is to seek God's cleansing healing in the sacrament of Reconciliation.






