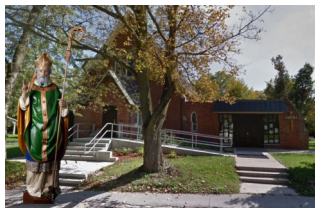

ENTERING INTO THE ADVENT SEASON:

First Sunday of Advent Reflection

This 1st Sunday of Advent marks the beginning of a new liturgical year. The readings during this time of preparation focus on making us aware that it's time to rouse from our sleep and prepare for the Lord's coming. Jesus says in the Gospel to "keep awake - for you do not know when the master of the house will come."

Advent and Christmas are also often times of lights. Whether it be lights on an advent wreath, a Christmas tree or festive lights decorating the house. However, above all these lights is Jesus, the true light of the world. This Advent we should strive to let the light of Jesus into our hearts so that it may even illumine and cleanse the dark and sinful areas of our lives. Our stewardship should reflect that light of Christ to others, so let us first be filled with what we seek to share.

One great way to invite the light of Christ into our lives is to seek God's cleansing healing in the sacrament of Reconciliation. 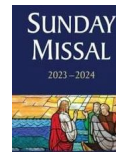



~ Go to Confession before Christmas.

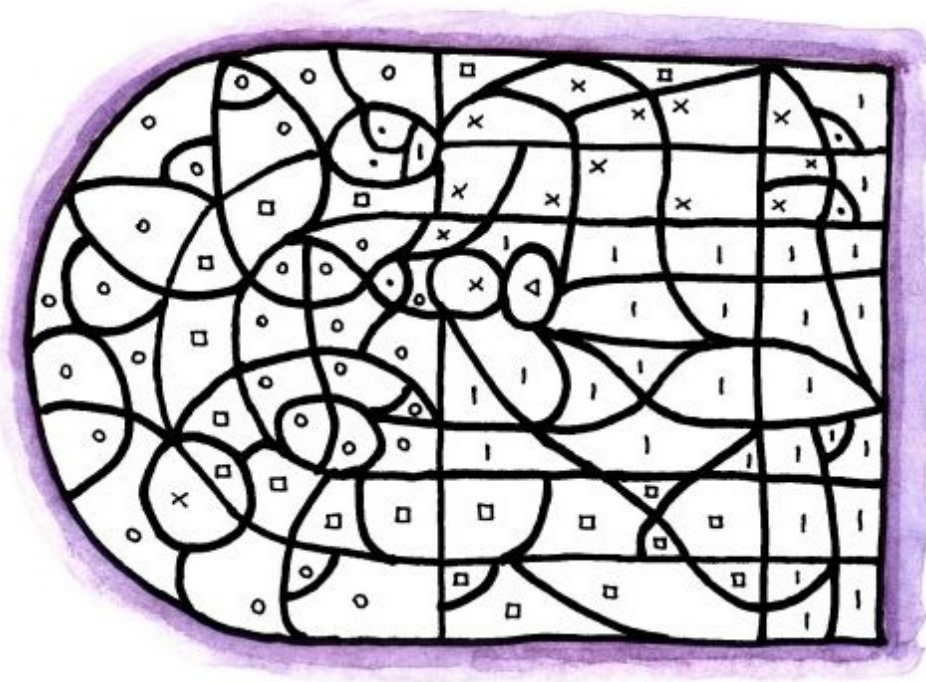

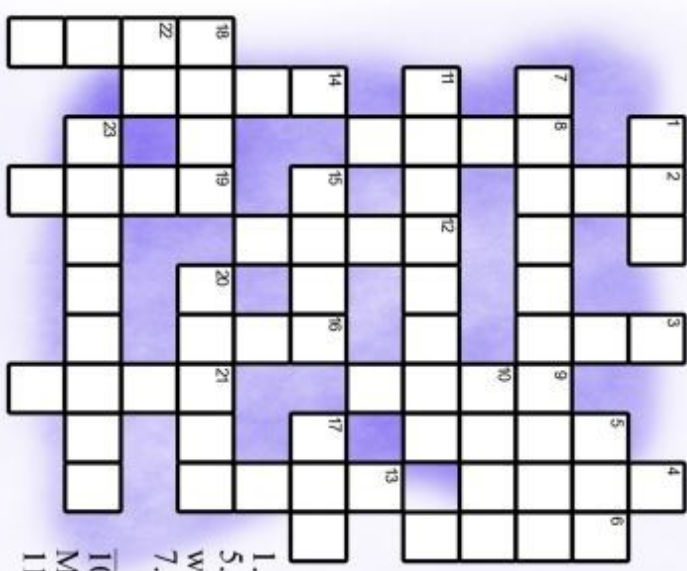
