The Bread from Heaven

Sharing what we have Received

This Sunday we celebrate the great Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, or Corpus Christi. This

Sunday offers us the opportunity to reflect more deeply on the importance of the **Eucharist** in our lives as stewards. The Catechism says that "the **Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life**" (Catechism of the Catholic Church 1324).

The **Eucharist** being the "source" means that through the reception of Jesus at the **celebration of the Holy Mass**, we receive the grace to "do all things through Him who strengthens us" (Phil 4:13). As stewards, we should remember that all of our charitable works are made possible and fruitful because of God sustaining us in all things. The **Eucharist** being the "summit" teaches us that everything we do should point us back to the Holy Mass which should remain the highlight of our entire week. **The Sacrifice of the Holy Mass** is everything. It is in the Holy Mass that **Jesus' perfect sacrifice at Calvary** is made present before us and is our closest foretaste of Heaven.

This constant interplay of source and summit is what should guide us as stewards. This image is best captured in the common practice of Corpus Christi Eucharistic processions. We first receive Christ in the Eucharist and then we bring Him out into the world for all to see. That is the life of a steward. Let us strive to receive Christ as often as we can, even on weekdays if possible. Once we have received Him in the Eucharist at the celebration of the Holy Mass let us then strive to share Him with others.
