A favourable place for the transmission and reception of faith is one's own family, where from generation to generation one shares experientially what one has received, that is, the convictions and certainties that flow from one's own

experience. Gathering around the table of **God's Word** enriches and strengthens the experience of the family as a "**domestic Church**". Set aside some family time for a short reading of a Scripture passage, for example, the **Sunday Gospel**. Choose a comfortable and quiet place in the home, away from the distractions of a television and cell phones. Begin with a prayer asking the Holy Spirit to open your hearts to **God's Word**. Read the passage aloud and then allow some time for the family to reflect and share their impressions. Finish with a prayer together that this Word will bear fruit in our lives, helping us in the walk toward holiness. - Assign a family member to collect artistic images that convey and express the biblical themes of a particular passage of Scripture. These images (a painting, a sculpture, a statue,

or even a piece of sacred music) can serve as a reference point for reflecting on the **Word of God** which takes artistic form in the Christian tradition.

- A moment of passing over the Word to the children.

- Praying the Rosary as a family.

Stewardship Reflection 1st Reading: Jonah 3.1-5, 10 2nd Reading: 1 Corinthians 7.29-31 Gospel: Mark 1.14-20 Jesus Calls The First Disciples -Fishing for Christ

"Come follow me and I will make you fishers of people." Just as Jesus called his first disciples 2000 years ago, he continues to call us to follow him. As we reflect on this beautiful Gospel account, let us focus on one particular aspect, the fact that Jesus uses the image of being a "fisher." It is most interesting to note that as he is calling actual fishermen, he uses their own language. There is a deep spiritual insight that can be gleaned from this, namely, that Christ uses what we bring to the table to serve Him and the Church. While fishing may seem unrelated to being an apostle, Jesus does not downplay their past experience. He invites them to bring all of the gifts and talents that they've received from God, but instead of using it for their own gain, to use it to gain souls for Christ. So too as stewards, we can sometimes think that God can only use us if we're already perfect disciples, or have degrees in theology or extensive training in ministry. However, the Lord wants us to bring all of our experiences, even our personal and professional backgrounds to serve Him. If we have backgrounds in finance or accounting, we can use that to help assist various parish ministries. Likewise, if we have experience as a teacher, we can utilize those gifts through various catechist or RCIA groups. This is the heart of stewardship. To recognize that we all bring our own particular gifts that can be used to serve Christ. Let us reflect on our own gifts and graciously heed the call to become "fishers of people,"



each in our own way. If you wish to serve our parish community by giving of your time, talent and treasure to support our parish ministries as an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion, Catechist, Altar Server, Lector, Usher, or Eucharistic


