Martyrs' Shrine & Sainte Marie Among The Hurons

Martyrs' Shrine, located in Midland, Ontario, is Canada's national shrine dedicated to the eight Jesuit martyrs who were martyred in the 17th century while evangelizing the Wendat (Huron) people. The Church features a distinctive design that blends Indigenous and European architectural styles. The shrine's 75-acre grounds offer peaceful gardens, walking paths, and outdoor chapels, providing visitors with a tranquil space for reflection and prayer. Each year, over 100,000 people visit the shrine to honor the martyrs and engage in spiritual activities. After lunch, we will visit Ontario's first European Community, Sainte Marie among the Hurons. This was the head-quarters for the French Jesuit Mission to the Huron Wendat people. In 1639, the Jesuits, along with French lay workers, began construction of a fenced community that included barracks, a church, workshops, residences, and a sheltered area for Native visitors. After extensive archaeological and historical research, Sainte Marie among the Hurons is now recreated on its original site, where the mission's compelling story is brought to life.




