

Over time, Tyler found the courage to face his story, make sense of his struggles, and take steps toward healing. Today, he says counselling has become something he looks forward to—even when it's hard—because it's helping him grow. Through ShareLife, you help people in our community access mental health services. You offer healing to those who feel forgotten and hope to those who are hurting. In our times of sadness or loss, it may seem as if joy and gladness will never return. Of course, we dare not sweep our sorrow and anguish under the rug. Our grief must be allowed to surface and given time to evolve, with God's help, from sadness into gladness. God promises that as we continue to trust in him as our source of comfort and hope, he will in time turn our mourning into joy. But when we are walking through a dark or lonely valley, we may be unable to see his light shining through the clouds of darkness and pain that overshadows us. Hope and healing break through our desolation when we discover that Jesus is already there in our midst. His presence may emerge through a hope-filled word from Scripture or a devotion, through a caring and understanding friend, or as we reach out to comfort someone else. Often it is only in looking back that we realize our Lord was with us the whole time.



When was the last time you laughed? I mean laughed so hard tears came to your eyes and you thought you would never stop laughing. Here's another question: when was the last time you wept? I don't mean teared up; I mean really and truly wept to the point where your stomach hurt and your heart ached and you thought, "When will it ever stop?" I think sometimes Jesus must look at our world and weep. I think Jesus says to you and me "Do you see what's happening all around you? Do you see the neighbour next door sitting alone on the front porch?" I remember how Jesus cried out from the cross for his father... and for me.
