Communion Reflection...How do you suppose John knew who Jesus was, the “Lamb of God”? Was it in the way Jesus walked with a steady confidence heading in John’s direction? Or maybe it was the way Jesus looked at John with eyes of understanding and love... the way he looks at us. Nevertheless, John knew it was time for his disciples to take their eyes off him and put their eyes on Jesus, who would take away the sin of the world. What John told his disciples to do seems critically important for us still today, namely, focus on the One that really matters in this life: “The Lamb of God,” Jesus. Jesus, the “Good Shepherd,” comes to fill our hearts with faith to see what John saw, so that we begin to follow Jesus into the heavenly sanctuary of our Heavenly Father.

The special Jubilee Year of Saint Francis proclaimed by Pope Leo XIV will take place from 10 January 2026 to 10 January 2027, on the occasion of the eighth centenary of the death of Saint Francis of Assisi. **St. Francis Prayer...**Lord, make me an instrument of your love. It’s difficult for me to envision what all took place at Jesus’ trial. He is beaten, whipped, spit upon, lied to and about, and yet “he did not open his mouth.” Had it been me, I would have been kicking and screaming, “You have the wrong man! I want a lawyer?” Well, they did have the wrong man. It should have been me on trial that day. It should have been me being slapped, whipped and beaten. It should have been me crucified on that hill Friday night. Instead it was Jesus who looks down from the cross and, when he finally does open his mouth to speak, tells me he loves me. “Father, forgive him,” he says. And I believe him. Now it’s my turn to open my mouth and tell his story. Lord, open my lips and my mouth will declare your praise.



People who have positions of power and authority at work or in society may be tempted to pull rank or bully others in order to get their way. But when power and authority are abused, it often leads to resentment and conflict. What a potent example Jesus gives of the power of powerlessness. He emptied himself of his divine prerogatives and took the form of a servant in order to fully bear his cross of suffering and humiliation. His powerlessness on the dark Friday was soon followed by his powerful victory over the powers of sin and death and Satan. What a compelling witness it is to God’s transforming love when his redeemed people put aside the prerogatives of their power and authority, and take on the form of a servant. As we show kindness and compassion to those under our authority, we are able to point them to the divine source of all mercy and truth. That’s the power of powerlessness.

What Should I do for Lent?

Keep it Simple... Prayer is a recognition that we need help to turn back to God. From daily Mass, to the Rosary, to Centering Prayer, to the Stations of the Cross, to Eucharistic Adoration, the Church encourages a wealth of prayerful practices. A very simple way to pray is to sit quietly for a moment before taking up one of the Gospels and slowly reading a passage that you like. Simply sit with the passage for a bit, savouring the Word and allowing it to touch you, read it again slowly, and then respond to God.
