Through ShareLife, you ensured Tyler didn't face his hardships alone Many of our brothers and sisters are struggling in silence. Because of your support of ShareLife, Tyler didn't face his hardships alone.

When he first came to counselling at a Catholic Charities agency you support through ShareLife, he was withdrawn and guarded—reluctant to open up. But slowly, with support, he began to share the weight he carried: the trauma of losing his father to a drug overdose and the pain of repeated loss in his family life. Over time, Tyler found the courage to face his story, make sense of his struggles, and take steps toward healing. Today, he says counselling has become something he looks forward to—even when it's hard—because it's helping him grow. Through ShareLife, you help people in our community access mental health services. You offer healing to those who feel forgotten and hope to those who are hurting.

The first ShareLife Sunday collection is on March 22.

Communion Reflection...The religious leaders knew well the prophecies of the Messiah. They should have realized that they fit Jesus to a T. But they dismissed that notion as foolishness. Three times Jesus told his disciples that he must suffer and die and rise again. And yet on Easter morning, they dismissed the testimony of the faith-filled women as nonsense. On Easter afternoon, the Emmaus disciples were clueless as to who was walking beside them. These days, even some people who consider themselves to be followers of Jesus dismiss the heart of the cross' message about sin and salvation as being merely symbolic or even foolishness. However, the cross of Christ reveals to us the heart of God's love and power and wisdom. It doesn't just show us the way. The message of the cross is the way to glory everlasting, so that we might live with him forever.

The special Jubilee Year of Saint Francis proclaimed by Pope Leo XIV will take place from 10 January 2026 to 10 January 2027, on the occasion of the eighth centenary of the death of Saint Francis of Assisi. St. Francis Prayer...Lord, make me an instrument of your love. Where the darkness of loneliness reigns let me bring the light of friendship. Where the darkness of bitterness reigns let me bring the light of forgiveness. Where the darkness of hurt reigns let me bring the light of healing. Where the darkness of discord reigns let me bring the light of harmony. Where the darkness of sadness reigns let me bring the light of joy. Where the darkness of doubt reigns let me bring the light of faith. Where the darkness of despair reigns let me bring the light of hope. And where the darkness of hatred reigns let me bring the light of love.

Dear Lord Jesus,

During this season of Lent, help us take good care of your creation, the gift you have freely given. May we cultivate and protect it for future generations. We also pray for persecuted Christians throughout the world. May all Christians who, on account of their faith, are discriminated against or are being persecuted, remain strong and faithful to the Gospel, thanks to the unceasing prayer of the Church.

Fasting and Feasting...Lent is more than a time of fasting, it can also be a joyous season of feasting. Lent is a time to fast from certain things, and to feast on others...

Fast from judging others, **Feast** on the Christ dwelling in them. **Fast** from emphasis on differences, **Feast** on the unity of life. **Fast** from darkness, **Feast** on the light. **Fast** from thoughts of illness, **Feast** on the healing power of God. **Fast** from words that pollute, **Feast** on words that purify. **Fast** from discontent, **Feast** on gratitude. **Fast** from anger, **Feast** on patience. **Fast** from pessimism, **Feast** on optimism. **Fast** from worry, **Feast** on gratitude.

I'm not all that steady on my feet these days. I know I'm getting old. I find that often I have to grab hold of things to keep my balance. I used to go walking until I discovered the ruts along the walkway seemed to be reaching out to trip me up. Or maybe the ruts are less to blame than my own unwillingness to admit I need help. I also lean on Jesus more as my physical limitations have reminded me how much I need my Saviour. My legs may not be as strong as they once were, but even with that, I still have Jesus. He's always there to catch me with his grace and forgiveness.



Why are people of faith so often drawn to the cross of Christ? When we come to the cross with our troubled and broken hearts, we not only see a tortured and broken body, but also a broken heart that yearns for our restoration

and reconciliation. We are pained by all of our wrongs and failures that made His sacrifice necessary. And yet we know that He is lifted there because it's the only way that our brokenness and the broken hearts of the world could be healed. As we stand beneath the cross of Jesus, our heart is drawn to the plight of the lost and broken people all around us and all around the world. Our heart aches and breaks for them. And we are moved by God's boundless love for all of his broken people to offer the healing touch of Christ's mercy and love through our caring words and actions, as well as our generous support of those who are on the front line of restoration and reconciliation.

What Should I do for Lent?

Keep it Simple...Prayer is a recognition that we need help to turn back to God. From daily Mass, to the Rosary, to Centering Prayer, to the Stations of the Cross, to Eucharistic Adoration, the Church encourages a wealth of prayerful practices. A very simple way to pray is to sit quietly for a moment before taking up one of the Gospels and slowly reading a passage that you like. Simply sit with the passage for a bit, savouring the Word and allowing it to touch you, read it again slowly, and then respond to God.
