**An Easter Celebration**

Easter morning, shining light,  
 From the tomb a glorious sight,  
 Angels rolled the rock away.  
 “Jesus is alive!” they say.  
 Forty days have quickly passed.  
 Now the story’s done at last.  
 Jesus rose to die no more,  
 Throwing open heaven’s door.  
 Run with Mary, tell your friends,  
 Give them joy that has no end.  
 “Celebrate in all you do.  
 Jesus gave His life for you.”



On Easter, our thoughts often turn to heaven. However, we often think of heaven as this less-than-real place. Call it “heaven-lite.” Why? Maybe because we cannot imagine anything weightier or more real than sickness, doubt, pain, betrayal, discord. The effects of sin are

weighty, crushing even! But why should our “less-than-real” ideas about heaven dominate us, when the biblical description is very real? After he was raised on the first Easter, Jesus passed through the locked door of the room where the disciples were—not because he wasn’t as real as the door, but because he was actually even more real than the door. He walked through that door as we walk through fog. The disciples thought he was a ghost until he ate with them. He showed them that he was real and risen. Jesus is real for us today on this Easter too, and he is alive for each of us. Jesus the Real One, has prepared a real place for us in his Father’s house. If it were not so, he would have told us. Christ has risen from the tomb to walk with us there, one solid footstep at a time.



**Holy Thursday** On this day, Jesus offered the very first Mass, fed His followers for the first time with the Holy Eucharist and ordained the first priests. He showed the depth

of His love by washing the feet (the act of a servant) of His apostles, and urged us to do the same. After Mass on this night, we take time to adore Jesus in the Eucharist and thank Him for His great love.

**Good Friday** Because of the wonderful act of love that Jesus performed, giving His life that we might all be able to live forever in His kingdom of love, peace and grace. We kiss the cross and try to understand why anyone would care so much about us.

**Holy Saturday** Also known as “Holy.” Tonight, those who have been preparing to become Christian accept Baptism and Confirmation. On this night we keep watch for the Resurrection of Jesus from the dead and sing the first “Gloria” and “Alleluias” of the Easter Season. We ring the bells to announce the Resurrection and the promise of new life. We all renew the vows of our Baptisms. May each of these days be special to us. May we each be prepared through Penance to receive the new life promised us by Christ. And may the Good Shepherd bless our parish family with special love and peace.



Jesus is risen! Alleluia! He is alive! These are the words we speak and sing today after 40 days of repentance, penance, service and prayer. Today the Church—like the

tomb—opens back up. Easter Sunday is more than another milestone moment in the life of Christ. It is our second chance and reason for our faith. Today our hope for something more-beyond the veil of this world—comes into view. Today the story of Jesus’ resurrection becomes the awesome and irreplaceable moment in our journey towards God. We are no longer slaves to sin and death because the gates of heaven have been thrown open wide. And it’s all free. It’s all grace. Today, live in the world with the kind of joy and hope that will encourage others to ask “why?”
