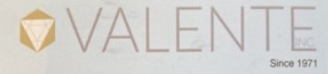

"If only I'd known. Why didn't you say something?" How often do we miss opportunities to reach out and then hide behind excuses to save face for not caring and being there when we were needed? There's no magic formula to helping others, except keeping our eyes open and our hands ready. Eyes open! Be alert. Is someone going through a difficult time? Check in on them. Is a friend keeping their distance after going through a painful stretch? Call. Knock. Reach out! You might be the only answer to helping them escape their isolation. Hands ready! Some things can't be put off. A new widow or widower might need a phone call or some conversation as they adjusts to living alone. Make the connection and don't wait for them to ask for help. We need to be there when we're needed and not only when it's convenient for us. Whenever possible, let's do something for others—even if we don't feel up to it. No excuses. Be there. God, make me a shelter and a safe place of healing for others.

LET US PRAY...GOD, give me eyes that I might see the work that can be done by me. GOD, give me ears that I might hear the cries of those who need me near. GOD, give me lips that I might speak comfort and peace to all that seek. GOD, give me a mind that I might know to help the ones that need me so.
