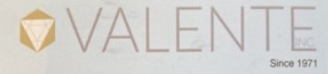

The Mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is not one we can explain or fully comprehend. Our finite intelligence cannot wrap itself around that which is infinite. But we can describe it. We speak of God as creator, source life, font of love. We see Jesus as Saviour, eternal priest, Lord and teacher. We see the Holy Spirit as life, love, power and sanctified. Our descriptions allow us to understand in part the mystery of God as he lives and acts in our lives. Contemplating the mystery of God can either overwhelm us or push us closer to belief. God is all that Jesus has revealed him to be. He loves us, redeems us and makes us holy. He shares himself with us. God is closer to us than we are to ourselves. The great mystery is not how God can be so great, but rather we are so great to God.



There is no cost for our salvation. It is God's free gift. But there is a cost to being a genuine disciple of Christ. Bearing his cross is a daily joy and challenge. It cannot be a now and then type of commitment. Many people are glad to join a church, but few are willing to bear his cross by becoming totally committed to Christ and his mission. At the end of a new member class, where the cost of discipleship was emphasized, a woman asked if social membership was offered at the church. The cost seemed too much to bear. Jesus' words are even harder to bear: "Whoever does not take up the cross and follow me is not worthy of me." But what a joy and blessing it is when we give even a cup of cold water to someone in his name.

It was then that I felt that the Lord was calling me to enter the seminary, though it took him a few years before I decided to go. Meantime, I studied theology at the University of Cardinal Stefan Wyszyński and worked. In 2009, I joined a community of the Neocatechumenal Way. It was in this community that in 2011, I made the decision to enter the Seminary. I was sent to the Redemptoris Mater Missionary Seminary of Toronto where I had one year of missionary experience in Israel and was sent to Blessed Sacrament Parish for my internship year. I am now finishing theological studies at Saint Augustine's. I was ordained on June 27th 2020 by Cardinal Thomas Collins and worked as an associate Pastor at St. John Chrysostom Parish in Newmarket from 2020-2023, Guardian Angels Parish in Orillia from 2023-2025 and currently St. Joseph Parish in Mississauga.

May is The Month of Mary

One sign of the Christian spirit is that our thoughts turn to the spiritual side of each season of the year. The month of December brings thoughts of Christmas; March is linked in our thoughts with Lent and Easter; October is the month of the rosary. And the month of May brings us memories of Mary and reminds us of our devotion to her. The union of the month of May and Mary is quite natural. The very names are interchangeable. The mood of May is the mood of hope and joy; Mary is the mother of hope and the cause of our joy. Ancient traditions have embedded themselves in the language and customs of every Christian nation. Sometimes we might wonder if we have lost our spiritual joy. In Canada we have few, if any, religious fiestas or festivals or processions with music and banners. But the month of May reminds us that joy is for the taking. As we honor Mary, may our devotion to her lead us to love and serve God joyfully. We can let go of grudging, reluctant duty, remembering instead our loving God and Mary our Mother. Then there will be springtime in our souls and Mary's own Maytime in our hearts.



Communion Reflection...A US Air Force pilot was shot down over Bosnia during the late 1990s. He heroically evaded capture for days until he was found by rescue helicopters. When the helicopter landed to rescue him, he did all he could to reach safety. He fought through bushes and dragged himself to get to the place of refuge. When we battle temptation, what do we do? Do we do all that we can to resist? If we are honest, probably not. We excuse, rationalize and often surrender. When faced with temptation, turn to our Lord. Pray, read Scripture and, most importantly, remove yourself from the situation. Take a walk. Call a friend. Do whatever you need to do to fight it off.

This weekend's 2nd Collection - ShareLife. This weekend is the final ShareLife Sunday of the year. But ShareLife is more than a collection. It's how we as a community say "we care." In solidarity with Catholics throughout the Archdiocese, we provide a witness of God's love by actively supporting those in need locally and the greater world.
