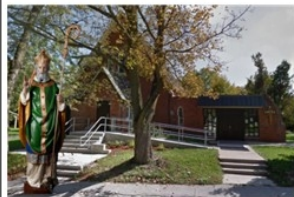

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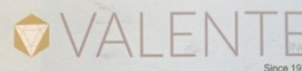

**Communion Reflection...**Have you ever had someone say, "I know how you feel!" but you think to yourself, "How can you possibly know how I feel? How can you know what I'm going through?" While we may think those thoughts, there's something inside that truly does long for someone to know how we feel. Perhaps if they did, some of the pain could be lifted as we are drawn to that person in compassion and love. The word compassion means "able to feel with, identify with the feelings of others." Matthew says that when Jesus saw the crowds as he made his way to the cross, "he had compassion for them." He didn't pity them, he actually felt their helplessness and pain of life.
